A102/A104 appliances integrate with any SMTP-based email system without separate email gateways. As a result, your company has the benefit of centralized fax and email management, while users have the convenience of a unified messaging environment.

## Production Faxing

OpenText Fax Appliance supports easy deployment of production faxing through the Drop Directory, allowing faxes to be sent without user intervention. The Drop Directory feature allows for an easily accessible directory for inbound faxes, allowing third party applications to retrieve the faxes stored there.

OpenText Fax Appliance offers a complete scan-to-fax solution by integrating with popular scanners and multifunction printers, such as Canon, eCopy, EFI, Hewlett Packard, Microtek, Minolta, Ricoh, Sharp, Toshiba, and Xerox.
